



The Oklahoma Psychological Association and Student Society (Division of Research and Training) announce a call for student presentations for the 2019 OPA Annual Convention. The conference will be held November 1-2 at the Oklahoma City Zoo. Please note that the conference is a Friday and Saturday and we will be doing video presentations in addition to an option for a traditional poster presentation.

Any student wishing to make a presentation at the 2019 conference may submit an abstract for review by the Program Committee. Abstracts are limited to 500 words and must clearly and concisely delineate the following sections: Problem, Method, Results, and Conclusions. Presentations may be of technical, scientific, or professional interest to psychologists. Please note, in keeping with the theme of this year's Conference, students will submit a pre-recorded video presentation of their research. The idea is to follow a Ted Talk style, summary of your research, followed by a brief question and answer period. Each video presentation must be submitted prior to the deadline, and may not be more than 5 minutes in length. Students who are not chosen for the video presentation are encouraged to present a poster.

It is highly encouraged, though not required, that research showcase innovative and novel approaches within the field of psychology. Preference will be given to research projects that are complete. The deadline for receipt of abstracts is **September 13, 2019**. Students will be notified of a decision regarding their submissions no later than **September 30, 2019**. And all videos will also need to be submitted by **September 13, 2019**.

A completed submission form (**page 2**) MUST accompany all abstract submissions.

OPA provides cash prizes for the most outstanding presentations in undergraduate and graduate student categories. Cash prizes will be awarded to first (\$100), second (\$75), and third (\$50) place contest winners in both the graduate and undergraduate divisions. Winners of the competition will be announced following the Student Presentations on Friday, November 1, 2019.

The Conference registration fee will be waived for any student that is a member of OPA who will be presenting their research. Otherwise, you are expected to register and pay for the conference if you are not a member and/or wish to participate in the entire conference November 1-2, 2019. Please note that there will be student volunteer opportunities as well.
