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## OBJECTIVES

- Learn the basic principles of a risk management strategy.
- Learn an approach to identifying and resolving complex, high risk dilemmas that frequently arise in professional practice, including:
  - the elements of risk managed self care recommended to deal safely with a patient suicide;
  - addressing the role of the psychologist in child custody disputes;
  - role conflicts that occur when combining forensic and clinical practice; and
  - legal and risk managed responses to requests for records in various situations, including legal system requests, parent requests and client requests.
- Learn to deal with challenges presented by online reviews and other challenges presented by the “online world.”
